



A Sad Story with a Happy Ending

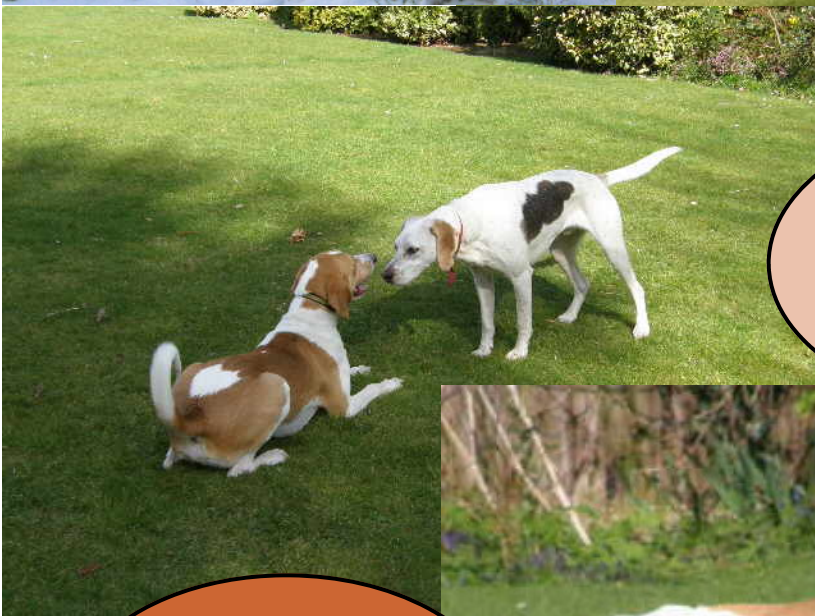
